# Year 6 Residential to Bewerley Park

Information Evening

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## Objectives

This residential is a fantastic opportunity for your child to experience new and exciting activities.

It helps to boost self confidence, teamwork and communication skills; providing them with a brilliant platform for the rest of Year 6 and for secondary school.

The activities are all led by Bewerley Park instructors, but children are left to complete tasks individually or in small groups/teams.

## Dates – Mon 3 Jun – Weds 5 Jun

Arrive at school normal time in class for registration and bag check. Children <u>WILL NOT</u> need a packed lunch – provided by Bewerley Park.

Leave school at about 9:30 – 9:45.

Arrive at approximately 10:15 - 10:30

- bed making and unpacking
- outline of the three days from instructors
- kitting out of waterproofs etc

#### **Activities**

Activities will likely be half day.

The activities are not finalised yet, but likely activities this year include:

- climbing/bouldering
- canoeing
- bushcraft and shelter building

All activities will depend on the weather and are run by the staff at Bewerley Park.

## Meal Times & Evening Activities

Children are provided with full breakfast, packed lunch and evening meal as part of the cost.

Children are responsible for serving and tidying their tables after every meal.

They are also expected to lay tables for other schools throughout the week.

Bewerley Park have several activities/games to use in the evening. There are also extensive grounds for the children to explore.

## Cost & Payment

Bewerley Park are charging £290 per child. We will also have to pay for transport which has yet to be finalised.

- Price includes accommodation, activities, meals and coach hire.

This will be available to pay via Parent Pay. Payment structures will be available:

- pay in full
- five or six monthly instalments

## Spending Money

Children are allowed to bring a maximum of £10 spending money to use in the tuck shop.

Tuck shop includes gifts, sweets, drinks etc.

If the children are not buying gifts, they will not spend the full ten pounds as their sweet/drink intake will be limited each visit.
