


The reading test takes place on the Tuesday morning

There are 50 marks available for this test.


Texts could be fiction, non-fiction or poetry.




The maths papers take place on the Wednesday and Thursday and consist of:


- arithmetic paper /40 (We

- paper 3 reasoning /35 (Thursday 40 mins)




Draw the reflection of the shape in the mirror line n = 22



### **Writing**

Grades for writing will be given based on evidence collected throughout the entire year across a range of different subjects.

Children will not be sitting a writing test.

Examples – stories, poetry, information texts, diary entries, recounts, science write ups etc.

#### <u>Results</u>

Children will receive a result from their GPaS, reading and maths tests.

This will be a scaled score where 100 is classed as 'working at the expected standard'.

#### <u>Results</u>

There will be no scaled score for writing.

For writing, children will be classed as either:

- working towards expected standard
- working at expected standard
- working at greater depth

Both teacher assessments and SATs results will be passed on to secondary schools.
