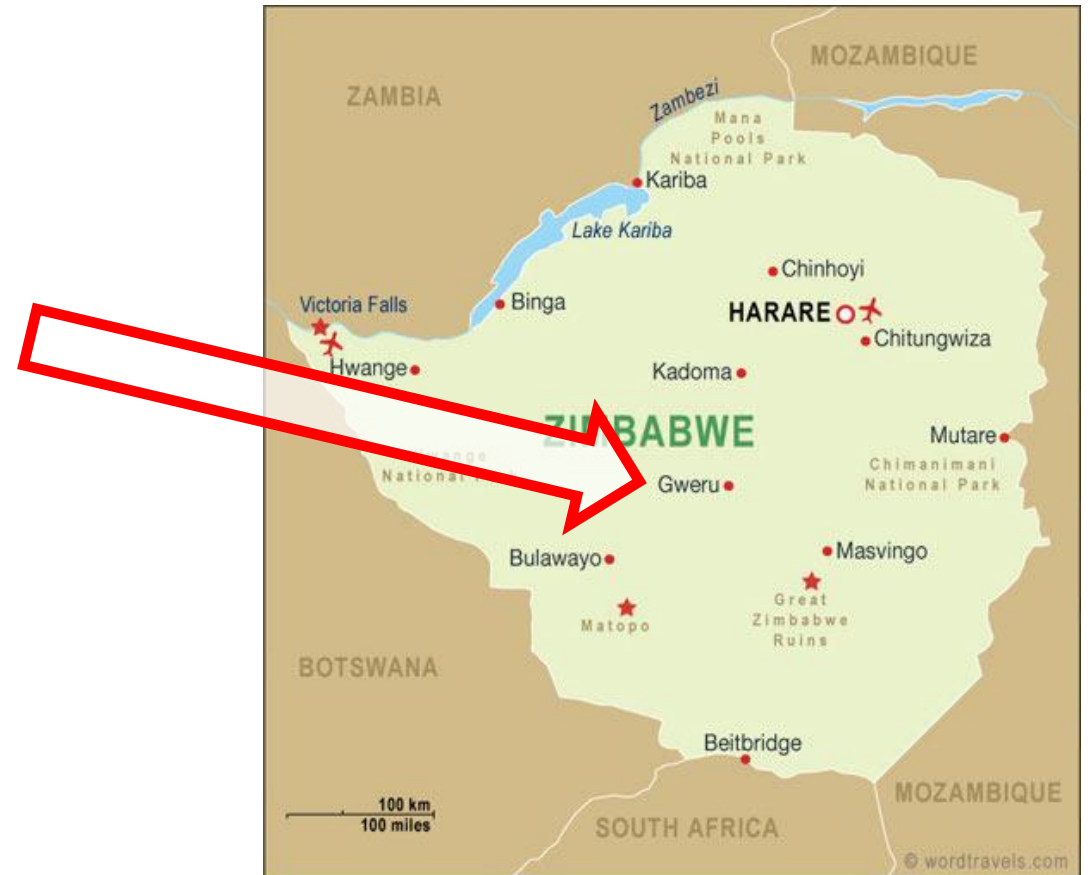
WHERE IS ZIMBABWE?
