## EYFS and Key Stage 1

Think then Click

These rules help us to stay safe when I go online:

• I only go online with a grown up.



• I am kind online.



• I keep information about me safe.



• I only talk to people online who I know in real life.



• I tell a grown up if something online makes me unhappy.



## Key Stage 2

### Think then Click

- I only use the internet when I have been given permission by a member of staff or my parent/guardian.
- I only use websites and search engines that my teacher or parent / carer has chosen.
- I always talk to an adult in school or my parent/carer if I'm not sure about something or if something happens online that makes me feel worried, frightened or upset.
- I will not use technology (images, videos, sounds or words) to be unkind to people, as this is cyberbullying.
- I will only post pictures or videos on the Internet if I have permission from my teacher or parent/carer.
- I will immediately close any web page I am not sure about.
- I never give out my own or other people's personal information (such as name, phone number, address, interests, school or clubs).
- I will not share my passwords with anyone except my parents/carers.
- I understand that some people on the internet are not who they say they are. I will not arrange to meet someone I only know on the internet. If someone asks to meet me, I will not reply to them and I will tell my teacher or a parent/carer immediately.
- I will not access games, apps or social networks that are for older children, as it may put me at risk.
- I have read and talked about these rules with my parents/carers
