These rules help us to stay safe when I go online:

- I always ask a trusted adult when I go online.
- I only play games or apps a trusted grown up chooses
- I am kind online.
- I keep information about me safe.
- I tell a trusted adult if something online makes me unhappy.
- I ask a trusted adult before I chat to someone online
- I only chat to people I know in real life.

Online Safety Rules

Key Stage 2

Think then Click

- I only use the internet when I have been given permission by a trusted adult.
- I never give out my own or other people's personal information (such as name, phone number, address, interests, school or clubs).
- I will not share my passwords with anyone except my parents/carers.
- At school, I only use websites, search engines, games and apps that my teacher has chosen for me.
- At home, I only access websites, search engines, games, apps or social networks that my parent/carer has chosen for me.
- I will stop if something makes me feel worried or unsafe and tell a trusted adult.
- I will close any web page I am not sure about and tell a trusted adult.
- I am kind and respectful online.
- I will only post pictures or videos on the internet if I have permission from my teacher or parent/carer.
- I always ask a trusted adult before downloading or buying anything.
- I understand that some people on the internet are not who they say they are. I will not arrange to meet someone I only know on the internet. If someone asks to

meet me, I will not reply to them and I tell a trusted adult immediately.
